New School Communications Platform: Arbor

We've moved to a new system called Arbor, replacing Classcharts, Edulink, and soon ParentPay.

It's a one-stop shop for all school communications and payments.

This is what you will need to do:

- Check your email for login details (including junk/spam folders).
- Set up your account at <u>login.arbor.sc</u> click "Forgotten Password" to get started.
- Download the Arbor Parent App from the App Store or Google Play.

Once set up, you'll be able to:

- Message the school
- Make payments
- Top-up catering balance (£2 min)
- View reports & behaviour info

PLEASE NOTE: ARBOR WILL NOW BE THE ONLY SYSTEM WE USE.

The Creative Arts Faculty is thrilled to kick off preparations for this energetic and fun-filled production!


