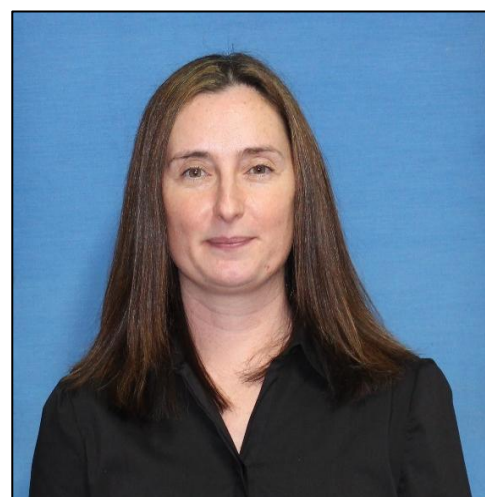

Induction Days

Arrival – On Thursday your child can arrive between 8am and 8:20am via the main gate and will be escorted to the hard court by staff. On induction day the new students will finish at 2:45pm; the rest of the Academy will finish at 3pm as normal.

Uniform

Thursday – Your child should attend wearing their **primary school PE kit** for the day.

Attendance – If your child is unable to attend for any reason, please email our Attendance Team: attendance@paigntonacademy.tsat.uk **We do need to be notified, ideally before 8:30am.**

Breaktime – Please provide **a snack** for your child to eat at breaktime.

Lunch – We will provide students with a **free** lunch on induction day and give them an extended lunchtime, as moving through the canteen can take longer as it is a new process for the students. If, however your child prefers a packed lunch, they will be able to use the dining area to eat this.

We will register students for the catering system on induction day ready for when they join us in September. Torbay Council supplies us with an updated list of those children eligible for free school meals so that will be available for those students in September.

Lunch Time Activities – Students will be able to use the library, the field for football (weather dependant) and we will notify students if any other clubs are available.

Transport – At the end of the day there are high levels of traffic immediately around the Academy. The car park is usually full and is closed between 2:55pm – 3:10pm. Many parents find it easier to meet their children a short walk from the Academy which makes it safer for our students. Some parents ask their children to wait for a few minutes and they pick them up 5 or 10 minutes later when the traffic around the Academy has eased. Please can we ask you to drive responsibly around Borough Road and park appropriately to help our neighbours access driveways at all times.

Praise – Reward Points – On the induction day students will be able to earn reward points when they are successful. From September students can convert their points into items from the CARE Store.

Golden Tickets - During each lesson one student will be awarded a golden ticket and we will draw out one golden ticket for each tutor group at the end of the induction day to receive a prize.

Tutor Groups – We know the students will enjoy the induction day, allowing them to make new friends, sample the environment of the Academy, find their way around and become confident about joining us in September. They have all been assigned a tutor group and they will register in this group for morning registration and be taught in this class for their lessons over the induction day. These groups will be their registration groups in September and might be subject to change when students start at the Academy. In Maths, English, PE and PSHE the teaching groups will be set differently; therefore students will also be in lessons with students who are not in their tutor groups.
