What to bring:

- Swimwear Wetsuit (if you wish)
- Sun lotion/hat
- Towel(s)
- Plenty to drink and a packed lunch, although food and drink may be purchased from the restaurants (burgers, hot dogs, chips etc, hot and cold drinks, slush, and ice-creams.)
- A small amount of money to buy any additional food and drink.
- Medication you would normally carry such as asthma inhalers.
- Lockers Initial entry to the lockers are included in the entry price. Subsequent visits are charged at 20p per locker. Change machines are available onsite (Locker fee is non-refundable).
- Students will only be allowed to stay in Quaywest after 3.00pm with written consent. We will NOT accept text messages or phone calls.

Do NOT wear:

Cut-off jeans and trousers, baggy shorts beyond knee length and transparent/inappropriate costumes are not permitted and do not wear swimwear with zips or buttons as these may damage the flumes. Please be aware that bikini tops can be dislodged.

Wear glasses on the flumes unless it is unavoidable then a disclaimer can be filled out at reception. Wear jeans, or other similar clothing, as they usually have small metal buttons on them, which can damage the rides. Wear goggles unless you really need to - Wear jewellery on the flumes, as it can cause damage and injury, and be easily lost. Please be advised white and luminous coloured swimwear does tend to go transparent, you will be asked by staff if they feel you are to be dressed inappropriately to get changed. Quaywest also cannot guarantee the fastness of the colour of your swimwear, although they use normal pool chemicals it may affect the colour. Quaywest has unisex changing village with individual private cubicles. Please note: Make sure that you check the water depth at exit of any other slide before you ride, the deepest pools are 1.2 M.
