## Year 10 Design and Technology

Year 10 GCSE Design and Technology students have been developing



their CAD skills to create prototypes using the brand new laser cutter.

Working quickly during one lesson students researched and designed a phone stand that could be batch produced in 3mm laser plywood!

Year 10 students will be using the laser cutter to create their own electronic products after the half term break.

#### Year 10 Drama

**Devising Discovery Platform - students** studying GCSE Drama took part in a series of outreach workshops 'Devising from Scratch' over the last two weeks. These workshops were led by visiting artists from Doorstep Arts in collaboration with Exeter University and the Northcott Theatre.

The students now have the opportunity to perform in the Devising Discovery Platform at the Northcott Theatre, Exeter. This platform brings together students from performing arts programmes across South Devon to perform on a professional stage.

Students spend a Saturday in the drama studios at the University of Exeter rehearsing their piece and meeting other secondary students from across Devon. They then take over the Exeter Northcott Theatre and perform for each other.

The day is fully supported by the University of Exeter Drama Department and an acclaimed
